

The Effect Of Using Image Media In Learning Literature On Increasing The Reading Interest Of Elementary Students 106810 Sampali Percut Sei Tuan

This study aims to determine the influence of using picture media in literature learning on improving reading interest of elementary school students. The method used is a quasi-experimental design with pretest-posttest control group design. The research sample consisted of 3 sixth- grade students taken using purposive sampling technique at SD 106810 Sampali Percut Sei Tuan. Data were obtained through reading interest tests and observations. The results showed that the use of picture media in literature learning had a significant effect on improving the reading interest of elementary school students (t = 5.26; p < 0.05). Therefore, it can be concluded that the use of picture media in literature learning can improve the reading interest of students at SD 106810 Sampali Percut Sei Tuan.
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INTRODUCTION

Therefore, this research was conducted to determine the effect of using media images in learning literature on increasing reading interest of SD 106810 Sampali Percut Sei Tuan students.

METHOD

This study used a quasi-experimental method with a pretest-posttest control group design. The sample of this research is students of class VI at SD 106810 Sampali Percut Sei Tuan. The number of samples taken was 35 students taken by purposive sampling technique. The experimental class was given treatment using media images in learning literature, while the control group was given learning literature without using media images. The research data were obtained through reading interest tests and observation. Data analysis used independent sample t-test.

RESULTS AND DISCCUSION
